

Dogwood Mountain Homeowners Association Meeting
September 22, 2012

1. The current financial report was given and will be posted on the web site. The current balance is \$27,287.09. The dues will stay the same at this time, \$50 a year.
2. CSA report. Mike Hankins has talked to Tom Nunes and was told that the paving equipment is coming down the hill closer to Shaver. They should be near Dogwood in three weeks. They have identified areas for repair and paving. Mike will call the county re: street signs. Three are missing or not in permanent bases. Cathy Bettencourt asked if they could add a NO EXIT sign on Little Shutteye.
3. The chipping program will begin on October 1. Mike Hankins has gotten the Foundation for Resource Conservation Inc. to come in and provide a free chipping service in Dogwood. Letters have been sent out to residents and is posted on the web site. Cathy Bettencourt asked that homeowners trim brush and trees along the road.
4. The upper entry sign is almost done. There was a problem with the lettering, trying to find it and the cost. Todd Briggs is making them and will have the sign done in about a month. Lighting will be added. Mike Hankins and Gary Bettencourt have cut trees at the entry for better sight when driving out onto 168.
5. The board will look at options for moving/changing the paper boxes at the lower entrance. The paper holders are unattractive to say the least.
6. Thank you to Gene McLean for the trash pick up along 168!!
7. Board members have agreed to remain for another year at least.
8. Cathy Bettencourt reported on the Fire Tax. We all got our bills. The protest can be turned in until October 7. Go to www.firetaxprotest.org for more information.
9. We talked about having a general neighborhood gathering. There are many new people in Dogwood. Jim McKoane offered his house. The Community Center was also mentioned. Any ideas??
